Proceedings:

I. Opening

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Parish Council President Jacques Pierini. Msgr. Malone offered an opening prayer. A motion was submitted and approved to accept the minutes of the May 2008 Parish Council meeting as submitted, with one correction to the Youth Director report.

II. Organization Reports (All reports presented by Representative unless otherwise noted.)

A) Finance Council – No report.

C) Parish Life and Outreach

2008-09 Charitable Funding proposal has been approved. Agencies have been notified and many have responded in appreciation.

H) CYM – Jordan Siebenmorgan reporting

CYM hosted a Mass for all graduation seniors, with Msgr. Present a crucifix to each, followed by a reception. Activities for CYM this month included Adoration in the Chapel followed by Open Youth Center “Study Break” and 6:00PM Mass with Team Jesus performing. The Catholic State Youth Convention was widely attended by CTK teens. Shelley McGhee received an award for her great work with the youth.

I) Youth Director

Jordan Siebenmorgan, our CYM parish representative, was given the St. Timothy Award at the 2008 State Youth convention on May 11. This award, given to only two youth in the state, is the highest recognition the Diocese of Little Rock can bestow upon a graduating senior high school youth

2008-09 Youth Advisory Team (YAT) interviews were conducted. The CYM staff and adult advisory board discerned 18 members for our team next year. The YAT retreat, focusing on team building, setting goals, and planning, is scheduled for July.

Upcoming summer activities include an evening of Kickball and Ice Cream, a summer TABs session, and Pizza and Movie night. Other July activities include a few service projects in the Youth Center, and a group of 9 teens traveling to Missouri for a national Youth conference.

SEARCH #117 will be June 27 -29. Once again, there will be several Christ the King youth participating in this weekend high school retreat at St. John’s Center, with 11 CTK teens on the teams in various leadership roles, and 17 CTK teens registered to attend.

The nursery will be open for weekend Masses throughout the summer, with the exception of July 4 weekend. The nursery office will be open on Tuesdays until the week of August 11, when it will be open Monday through Thursday
- Mother's Day Out 2008-2009 School Year-- The three year old class is full, with a waiting list. We have openings in both the two year old and 18 month old classes. All staff is in place for the 2008-2009 school year based on current enrollment.
- Nursery Registration for the 2008-2009 year will be held on the weekends of August 16/17 and August 23/24. . 135 families have registered in the nursery.
